The boatman tries to throw Jonah to the whale, but the whale gets your coin instead. (Original produced 1880.) 10 1/2" long.



The penny goes so fast you might never see it if it weren't for this special photo.

Look closely.

The pitcher tosses the penny through the air (about 5"); the batter turns, swings and misses, Penny goes into bank through catcher.

Trick Pony.

Put penny into pony's mouth: he arches his neck, nods his head and drops coin into manger. (Original produced 1885.) 8" high.



22-290 Bulldog. Wag the bulldog's tail and watch him snap as he gobbles up your coin. 7 1/2" high.



22-120 Owl. Pull the lever and watch the owl turn his head and deposit your penny. (Original produced 1880.) 7 1/4" high.



22-240 Cat & Mouse. The grinning pussycat stands on his head to drop your money into the bank. (Original produced 1891.) 11" high.
