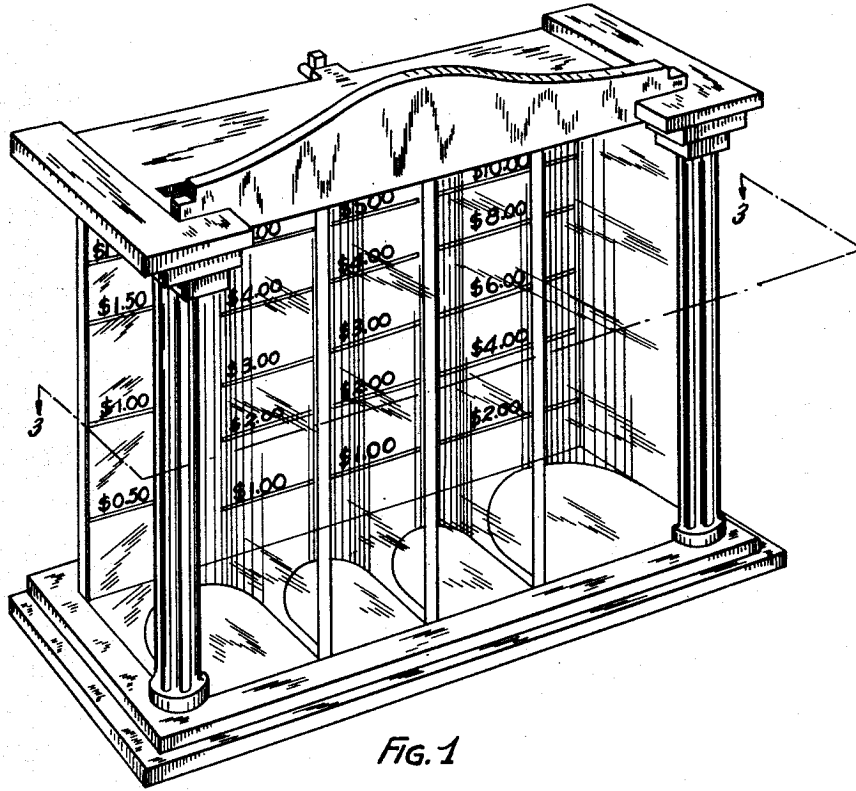

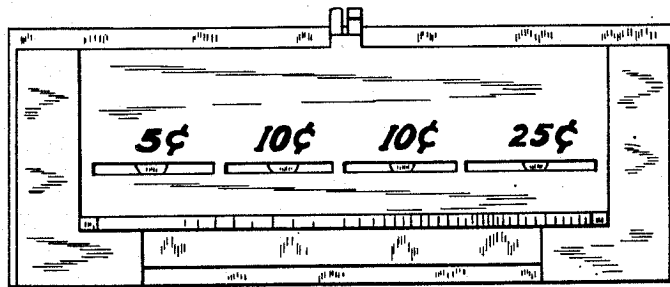

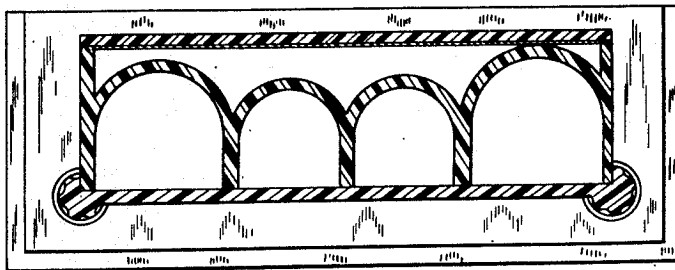

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Claud A. Thompson, a citizen of the United States, residing at Cleveland, county of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Savings Bank, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front perspective view of the savings bank, showing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and

Fig. 3 is a sectional view thereof taken on line 3—3 of Fig. 1.

Fig. 1 is shaded to indicate transparency.
