

DESIGN FOR A TOY SAVINGS-BANK.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 16,171, dated July 14, 1885.

Application filed June 12, 1885. Term of patent 7 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, CHARLES G. SHEPARD and PETER ADAMS, Jr., residing at Buffalo, in the county of Erie and State of New 5 York, have invented and produced a new and original Design for Toy Savings - Banks, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

This design relates to the general configuration of an ornamental toy savings-bank which is clearly represented in the accompanying drawing, making part of this specification.

A represents the elongated base of the savings-bank, provided at one end with a raised seat, a, upon which rests the figure, B, of a

girl. C represents the figure of a dog sitting on the base A in front of the girl and facing the latter. The right hand of the girl holds 20 a fan, and the left hand is lifted up, as if motioning to the dog.

We claim as our design-

The design for a toy savings-bank, consisting of a base and the figures of a girl and a 25 dog resting on said base, substantially as shown and described.
