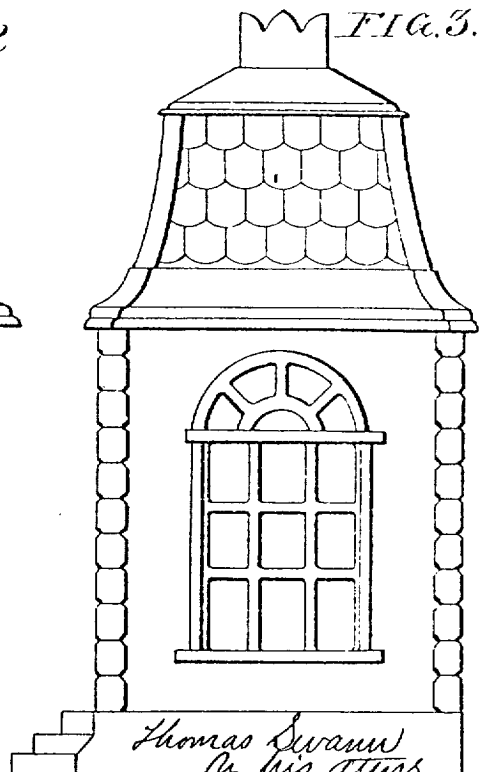
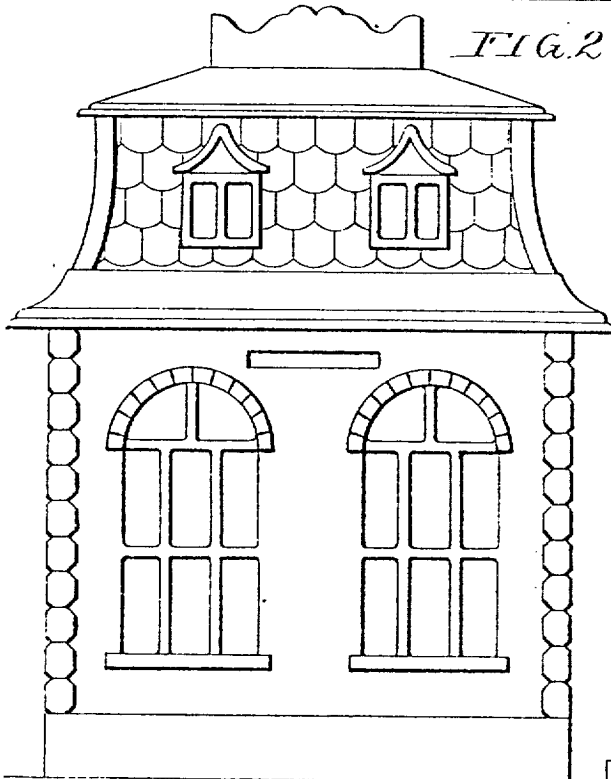
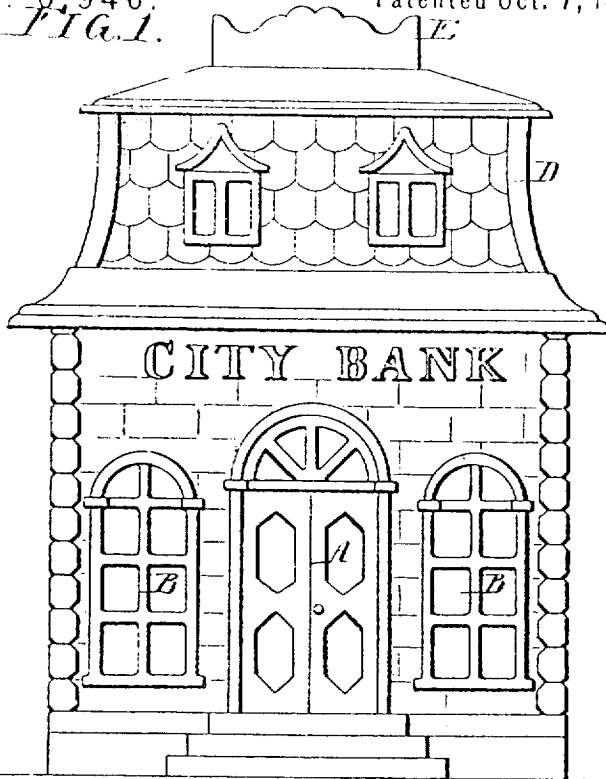

## DESIGN FOR A TOY BANK.

Specification forming part of Design No. **6,946**, dated October 7, 1873; application filed September 16, 1873.  
[Term of Patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, THOMAS SWANN, of the city and county of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for a Toy Bank, of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, Figure 1 being a front view, Fig. 2 a rear view, and Fig. 3 an end view, of the toy bank.

The front has an imitation door and doorway, A, with arched top, and on each side of the doorway is a window, B, the front of the toy building being scored and otherwise made to represent stone-work, and the whole being surmounted with a mansard roof, D, having dormer windows and a projection, E, at the top to represent a chimney. The rear of the toy bank, Fig. 2, has two windows and no doorway. With these exceptions, it is similar to

the front. Each end of the toy bank, Fig. 3, has a single window, the remainder of the design being similar in character to the front and back.

I claim—

1. The design for the front of the toy bank, as shown and described.
2. The design for the rear of the toy bank, as illustrated and described.
3. The design for the end of the toy bank, as shown and described.
